Classes 1, 5 & 9	2 x 454g jars LIGHT LIQUID honey.
Classes 2, 6 & 10	2 x 454g jars MEDIUM or DARK LIQUID honey.
Classes 3, 7 & 11	2 x 454g jars SET/CREAMED honey.
Classes 4, 8 & 12	One plainly moulded cake of beeswax (minimum weight 150g).
Class 13 *	2 x 454g jars LIGHT LIQUID honey.
Class 14 *	2 x 454g jars MEDIUM or DARK LIQUID honey.
Class 15 *	2 x 454g jars SET/CREAMED honey.
Class 16 *	2 x 454g jars HEATHER honey
Class 17	One plainly moulded cake of beeswax (weight between 400-500g).
Class 18	One shallow frame of comb honey for extraction
Class 19 *	Two containers of cut comb honey in standard 8oz (227g) commercial containers
Class 20	COMPOSITE EXHIBIT comprising: - 2 x 454g jars LIQUID HONEY OF CONTRASTING COLOURS. 1 x 454g jars SET/CREAMED honey. One plainly moulded cake of beeswax (minimum weight 150g).
Class 21	One BOTTLE OF MEAD (sweet)
Class 22	One BOTTLE OF MEAD (dry)
Class 23	One HONEY CAKE (strictly to the recipe on the entry form).
